- 6. **School Library:** Grand Opening took place on November 24, 2015, and will have its own page on the web site. Students are required to apply for a "job" to help out. They need to fill out full job application including references.
- 7. **Enterprise City:** Mrs. Weigler entered Founders in a raffle in which the school won a scholarship for up to 80 students to participate in the program at no cost (transportation not included). Tentative date of the trip is March 30, 2016 coordinated by Ms. Efraimson.
- 8. **Charity:** The Random Acts of Kindness Club collected over 3,000 food items for Liberty House (homeless veterans) as well as Giving Tree gifts in December; Lopez Advisory (with the help of Dean Mooney) collected games and craft supplies for CHaD.
- 9. **Volunteer(s) of the Quarter:** The Founders will recognize Volunteer(s) of the Quarter.
- 10. **Field Trips:** "A Christmas Carol" at the Palace Theatre in December; February trip to Vertical Dreams for 9th graders; Enterprise City in March; Shakespeare Folio at Currier Gallery of Art in April.
- 11. **Safety Committee:** The school conducted a lockdown drill during the change of classes.
- 12. **Curriculum Committee:** The Committee has started to plan for the next school year in the subjects of History, English, Foreign Language, Technology. Mr. Van Ewyk chairs the committee.

- 13. **Scheduling Committee:** The Committee has started to plan for the next school year. Mr. McKenzie chairs the committee.
- 14. **FIRST LEGO League and Recycling:** Parent volunteers advised two teams for FIRST Lego League. Two recycling programs established at Founders as part of their projects.

While all donations are valued by the school it is necessary to insure acceptance of only those donations that may not have a negative impact on the school for any reason.

Specifically (but not exclusively), donations that may be a burden on Founders:

- Older appliances
- Dated computers or related equipment
- Chemicals (classroom or cleaning related)
- Any item that carries a disposal charge for any reason
- Software lacking the appropriate licenses

Dean of School's Report February 17, 2016

- 1. Admissions: The application deadline closed on January 29, 2016. Placement exams are in progress.
- 2. Honor Roll: The second quarter ended on January 22. The following percentages of students made the honor roll: 15% made High Honor Roll; 39% made Honor Roll; 12% made Honorable Mention.
- 3. Faculty Updates: Teacher assessments are in progress in three parts: self-assessments, in-classroom observations, and individual meetings. "Intent to Return" forms were distributed to faculty. Full faculty meetings are being held to discuss school-wide topics including mastery, advisory, discipline, character grading, writing across the curriculum, and other topics.
- 4. Curriculum & Scheduling Committees: The Curriculum Committee started to plan for the next school year in the main subjects and required electives. Mr. Van Ewyk chairs the committee. The Committee has started to plan for the next school year. Mr. McKenzie chairs the committee.
- 5. Founders' Web Site: Phrases capturing the school's mission are being added to the home page. "In the Words of Parents" and "In the Words of Teachers" sections are being added to the web site.
- 6. "Advisory" to "Round Table:" Advisory was be renamed "Round Table" and features a new and updated syllabus in preparation for next school year to enhance the school's mission.
- 7. Job Fair: Founders will host its first Job Fair on March 9 from 4 to 7pm at the school.
- 8. Popcorn Maker: Several Founders' families contributed an industrial sized popcorn maker.
- 9. Subcommittees: Three new subcommittees were created Professional Development, Smarter Balanced Test 2016, and Furniture.
- 10. Smarter Balanced Test: The testing windows for 2016 are: March 29-May 6 for grade 6; and April 12 June 10 grades 7 and 8.

- 11. Charity: Ms. Small's Round Table raised money for school supplies, and Ms. Henry's Round Table will be raising money for the Boys and Girls Club.
- 12. Teacher of the Month and Volunteer(s) of the Quarter: The Founders recognized Ms. Henry in February as Teacher of the Month, and Patrice Benard is the Volunteer of the Quarter.
- 13. Winter Soccer League: Parent volunteer Tim Filep coordinates and coaches an indoor soccer league, along with Ms. Efraimson. They play at the Bedford Sportsplex.
- 14. Field Trips: Enterprise City in March; Shakespeare Folio at Currier Gallery of Art in April; Science lake cruise on Squam Lake and Field/Forest trip in May; Washington DC trip and Great East Festival in May; Walden Pond in June.
- 15. Dress Code & School Supplies 2016-2017: The school Dress Code, and supplies (for grades 6-8) will be announced in March for the 2016-2017 academic year.
