SAT/PSAT/SAS (ELA & Math)

- 4/19 (Wed) ; Grade 8 (PSAT); Grade 9 (PSAT); Grade 11 (SAT makeup) Only 8th and 9th grade students attend school
- 5/3 (Wed) Grade 8 (SAS) Only 8th grade students attend school
- Anytime in April/May Grades 5 & 6 (SAS) Rest of school will have normal school. See information from the team.

SAS Science (During normal school day; Held during normally scheduled Science classes)

- Grade 5
 - Any day in May not taken already by Grade 8 or 11
- Grade 8
 - 5/10 & 5/11 (Wednesday/Thursday)
- Grade 11
 - 5/17 (Wednesday) A/B Periods (during Chemistry class)

If you do not want your child taking any of the required tests (SAS or SAT) you must submit this form (you need to make a copy) to the front desk.

Who can apply? Any parent or guardian of a Founders Academy student

What are the duties of a Founders Board member? 


