What is the process to become a board member? Interested parents apply by sending their resume/CV to Kimberley Lavallee kimberly.lavallee@tfanh.org.

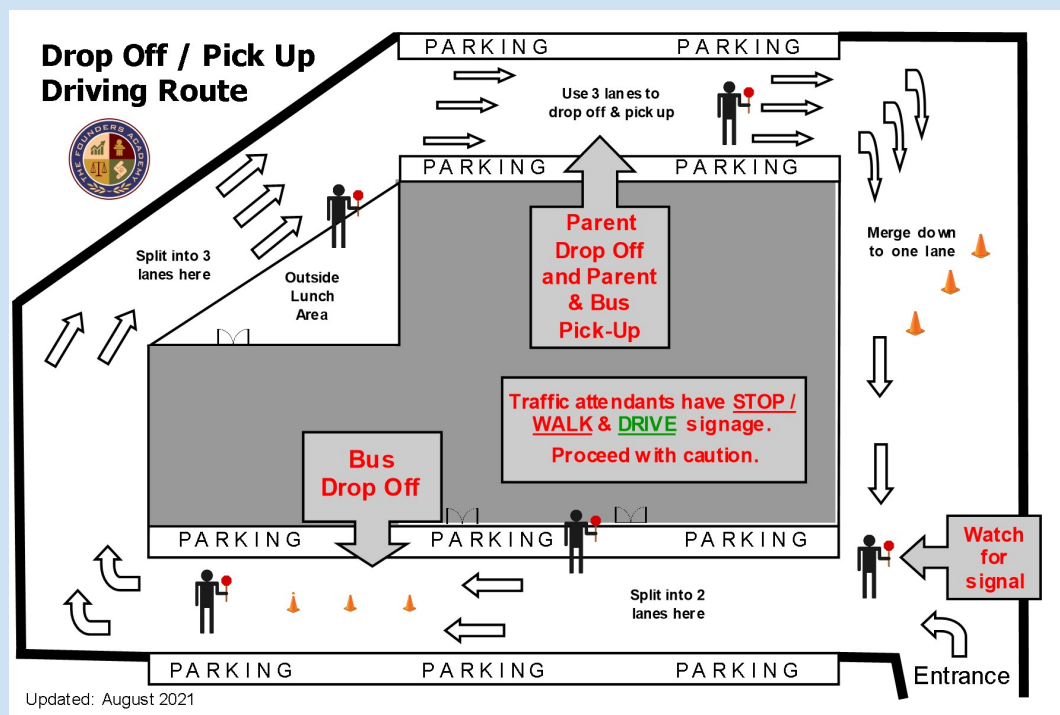

Students and chaperones will be picked up at the Derryfield Park on Sunday morning by motor coach, air conditioned with lavatory facilities, to begin one of the most fascinating and rewarding experiences of their lives. While in Washington, DC, their tour will be conducted by experienced, licensed tour escorts and guides. All meals on tour, as well as transportation, lodging, chaperonage, admissions, escort and guide services, complete insurance, evening activities, taxes and tips are included in the tour fare.

PLEASE NOTE: Due to extremely tight scheduling, we will be unable to allow time for religious services on Sunday.

The cost for this tour, including transportation, is \$839.00** per person, based on capacity for the motor coaches. **Accommodations will be on a quadruple occupancy basis for students, double occupancy for adults.** Participants will be signed up on a first come first served basis, with additional students placed on a waiting list. **In addition, the group coordinator has established November 1, 2022 as the registration date. Registrations will be accepted beyond November 1st, based on capacity of the trip.**

Again, since this is not a school or city sponsored trip, please do not call the school.
