Founders is looking for team members for the Walk To End Alzheimer's this year!

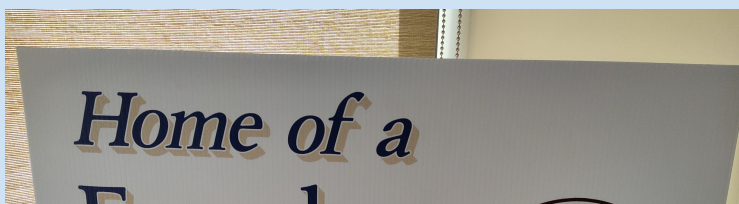
