Tests requiring Computers are in **PINK**. All other tests are paper/pencil.

SAT/PSAT/SAS (ELA & Math)

- **3/22 (Wed)** - ; **Grade 11 (SAT)** - Only 11th grade students need to attend school
- **4/12 (Wed)** - **Grade 7 (SAS)**; Grade 10 (PSAT)- Only 7th and 10th grade students attend school
- **4/19 (Wed)** - ; Grade 8 (PSAT); Grade 9 (PSAT); Grade 11 (**SAT** makeup) - Only 8th and 9th grade students attend school
- **5/3 (Wed)** - **Grade 8 (SAS)** - Only 8th grade students attend school

- **Anytime in April/May** - **Grades 5 & 6 (SAS)** - Rest of school will have normal school. See information from the team.

SAS Science (During normal school day; Held during normally scheduled Science classes)

- Grade 5

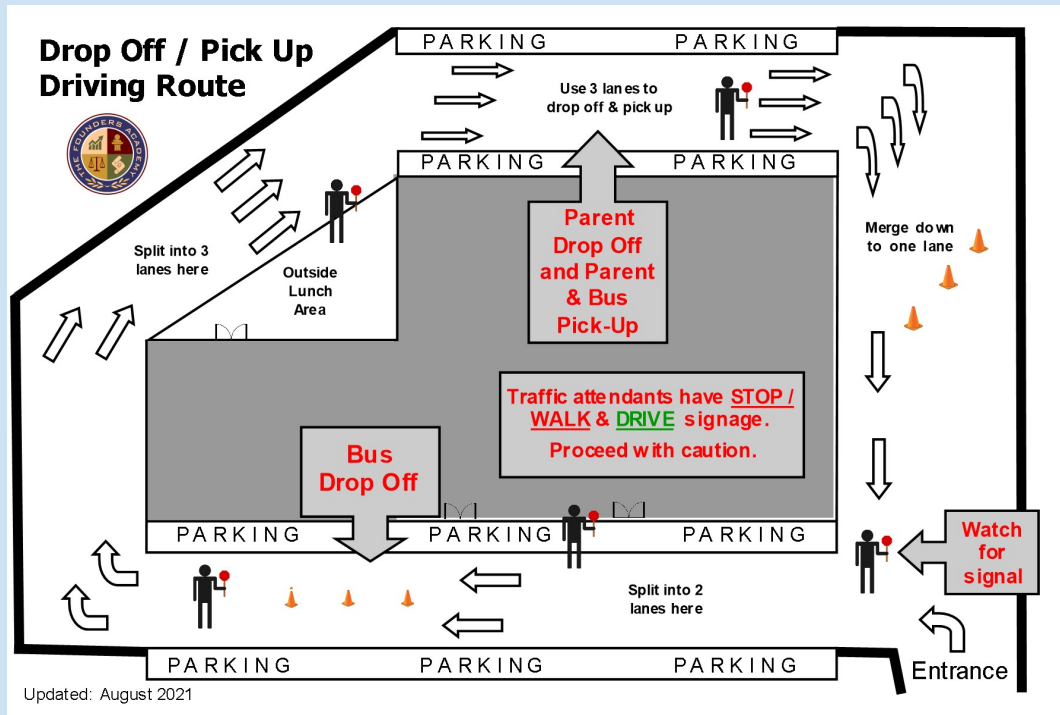
Traffic Pattern

1. Do not let your child out of the car until they see a traffic attendant with the "walk" sign showing. Safety is a top priority.
2. Students should be dropped off and picked up in the back of the building only, except for 2:25 dismissal.

3. All cars should pull up as far as possible in the back of the building. Do not stop until you cannot go any further.
