A couple points to note:

- 1. There's a typo on the McIntyre website. Registration is open for ages **6-16** (not 6-12). All skill levels are welcome. We LOVE having teens try out skiing/riding for the first time and this is a great place to learn!
- 2. Siblings are welcome to sign up using our TFA link. They do not need to be TFA students.
- 3. Transportation is not provided.
- 4. Students who are at Level 4+ can opt OUT of lessons and get an "Open Ski" pass for only \$100.
- 5. Chaperones are needed. You'll get a free lift ticket and rentals for each session. Mrs. Jackie Meilleur Dean of Students Grade 8




Teacher, Spanish & Dean of Students



Traffic Pattern


