
The Founders Mission Statement

Admissions for the 2024-2025 School Year

The Founders Academy Public Charter School will open Admissions for the 2023-2024 school year on September 15, 2023.

Applications for the 2024-2025 school year are due by March 15, 2024.

To apply for admission for grades 5-12, please fill out an <u>online application</u> and submit that with the associated admissions materials.

The Founders Academy is an open enrollment, public charter school serving grades 5-12. New Hampshire applicants who meet the school's admission criteria may apply. The school may accept out-of-state applicants at a fee to be set annually, on a space-available basis. It is important for any applicant considering enrolling at The Founders Academy to be certain that they are interested in pursuing a rigorous education within the <u>mission and vision</u> of our school.

Founders' curriculum focuses on student character and a classical education, including studies in history, leadership, ethics, debate, business and finance, classical literature as well as the standard high school curriculum of math, science, languages, and the arts.

Picture Retake Info

Hi Everyone,

We're the staff from C3 School Photography, your school's photographer! **Picture retake day is coming up (October 24th)** and that can sometimes bring confusion with it. This email is going to go over all things ordering for several scenarios to help smooth things out! Our office hours are Monday through Thursday, from 10:00 to 4:00, so if you have any additional questions not addressed in this email, please reach out!

I wasn't able to preorder, but I'd like my child's picture!

No worries! If your child attended the original picture day, they had a photo taken, regardless of if you ordered or not. When pictures are passed out at the school, your child will receive a 'proof' with their picture and specific instructions for you to go online and order. You will not be able to order through the prepay page on our website; instead, scroll down past the blue bar and click on the red "I HAVE A GALLERY CODE" button. Click on this link to order after picture day.

My child missed picture day, how do I order their pictures from retake day?

If your child missed picture day and you did not already place an order, you can do so through the prepay site. We are going to reopen the site and reactivate the codes; your code is FOUNDERS23. After entering the code, you will be able to search for your child by name. Only use the prepay site if you did not already place an order. If you have already placed an order, please turn your attention to bullet point 3. Click on this link to order before retake day and remember to scroll down below the blue bar!

My child attended picture day, but we are not happy with the photo. How do I place an order for retake day?

First, we are so sorry that you did not enjoy your photos. If it was an external circumstance (my son's hair was in his eyes or my daughter wasn't smiling, for example) please send us a note with how to change the picture. We are happy to receive any feedback to ensure that you get photos you love! As for ordering, you do not need to reorder. Simply have your child bring the photos from the first picture day to retake day. We will collect that package, and reorder the same one with the new pictures for you. You can write any notes on the package paper for us to read. Again, there are no extra steps: as long as your package is returned, we will automatically reorder the same package with the new pictures for you. You will not be able to order retake photos through either the pre or post-pay pages on our website. If you wish to not have the photos or retake then we do offer a 100% guarantee. We'll need the packages back and you'll get a refund mailed to your home.

- Third Prize: \$50 to the student who sells the third most tickets


Every student who turns in a minimum of 10 tickets will receive a small token of thanks.

Please consider donating to help create a more welcoming space for our younger students.


Amazon Wish List: Physical Education Needs
