
## The Founders Mission Statement

## Admissions for the 2024-2025 School Year

*The Founders Academy Public Charter School will open Admissions for the 2023-2024 school year on **September 15, 2023.***

*Applications for the 2024-2025 school year are due by **March 15, 2024.***

To apply for admission for grades 5-12, please fill out an [online application](#) and submit that with the associated admissions materials. Students who are already enrolled do not need to re-apply. All siblings DO need to apply.

The Founders Academy is an open enrollment, public charter school serving grades 5-12. New Hampshire applicants who meet the school's admission criteria may apply. The school may accept out-of-state applicants at a fee to be set annually, on a space-available basis. It is important for any applicant considering enrolling at The Founders Academy to be certain that they are interested in pursuing a rigorous education within the mission and vision of our school.

Founders' curriculum focuses on student character and a classical education, including studies in history, leadership, ethics, debate, business and finance, classical literature as well as the standard high school curriculum of math, science, languages, and the arts.

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## Alma Alert Notifications

We will now be using Alma for mass notifications such as snow days or other time sensitive notifications. Messages will only send as text messages when the user has confirmed that setting; otherwise, it will be sent via a phone call. If the same number is listed for multiple users, the number will only be called once. The first number listed will be the one called/texted (this also applies to emails). Please check your portal to make sure the number listed is the one you would like to receive the notification to.

**notification preferences** in Alma. Parents can choose how they want to receive emergency alerts, as well as attendance and assignment notifications.
