Before & After School Program 2023-24

Founders Academy is happy to announce the return of the After-School Program and the Before School Program for the 2023-2024 Academic Year. The Before School Program allows parents to drop their children off to be supervised prior to the start of the academic day. The after school provides adult supervision and support for students.

Before School Care will start on September 6th, After School Care (homework club) will start on September 7, 2023.

PROGRAM HOURS

Before School Care: 7:00 AM – 7:20 AM

At 7:20am students will go to the cafeteria until the start of the school day.

After School Care: End of school day – 6:00 PM

PLEASE NOTE: Students who are not picked up by 6pm will be charged an additional fee of \$10 for every 5 minutes late.

Bussing Information

We understand that those who signed up for bussing are anxiously awaiting routing information.
