As of 4/20/22 we have 179 total applications for the 2022-2023 school year. 155 applications are complete. As of 3/16/22 we have a waitlist for 9th grade and as of 4/14/22 we have a waitlist for 8th grade. We're approaching a 7th grade waitlist.

Since the last board report, we've added 47 total applications with 42 of them complete. Beginning the week of March 7th, we had double digit application submissions for 5 consecutive weeks–a first for admissions since the school started.
