3. Admissions Update:

As of 1/19/22, there are 80 applications for the 2022-2023 school year, 61 of them are complete.

At this time last school year we had 50 applications with 33 of them complete.

Since the beginning of the 2021-2022 school year, we have had 18 students withdraw from Founders while we have added 32. **Overall gain: 14 students**

During the 2020-2021 school year (during this same exam week), we had 14 students withdraw while we added 10 students. **Overall loss: 4 students**

During the 2019-2020 school year (our last pre-COVID school year during this same exam week), we had 31 students withdraw, while we added 19 students. **Overall loss: 12 students**

We have 5 new students beginning at Founders on **Monday, January 24th**. If they join as planned, we will have admitted **37** new students since the first day of school on September 8, 2021, which is the same amount as all of the 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 school years <u>combined</u>.
