3. Admissions Update: Admission for the 2022-2023 school year opened today. We are now accepting applications for students who will be enrolling in 5th grade for the 2022-2023 school year. A Public Notice about Admissions opening has been posted on our website, Manchester post offices, and sent to all press contacts. We are still accepting applications for students in all grades for the 2021-2022 school year on a space-available basis.

We received a total of 222 applications for the 2021-2022 school year. This is the second highest number of applications for any school year. The 2016-17 school year had a total of 198 applications, the 2017-18 school year had 166 applications, the 2018-19 school year had 195 applications, the 2019-20 school year had 200 applications and the 2020-21 school year had 226 applications.

4. Busing Update: Students will have the opportunity to ride the bus using neighborhood bus stops, just like the traditional public school students. Students who live in the Central HS and West HS district will go to Cardinal Lacroix School and take a shuttle bus to Founders. Students who live in the Memorial HS district will take a bus or walk to Memorial then take a shuttle bus to Founders. Afternoon drop off will directly to the neighborhood stop. Founders will have staff at the transfer locations for the first few days of school.

All bus rules from the Manchester School District will be followed.
