3. Admissions Update: As of November 7, 2023, we have 43 applications for the 2024-2025 school year. At this time last year, we had only 23 applications. Twenty-three of our 43 applications for the 2024-2025 school year are for 5th grade.

We hosted our second Admissions Info Night on November 1st with 13 families in attendance. The morning after, a new survey was sent to all families that attended to get their feedback on the event. All feedback was very positive and this survey will continue to be sent to gather feedback from attendees. Some comments from the 11/1/23 night included:

- 4. School Safety Updates: Safety is a top priority at Founders. We take great pride in putting multiple layers of protection in place for our students. We work very closely with the Manchester Police Department, Manchester Fire Department, and other state health and safety officials. We have several layers of protection in place and train both students on staff on how to respond in an emergency. Currently, some of the security features include locked exterior and interior doors at all times, Nightlocks, InForce 911 and regular drills. We are applying for the most recent SAFE grant to add more security features such as updated cameras, alarms on doors when they are propped open, and a new alert system.
