## CONFIDENTIALITY

It is the policy of the Founders to respect the privacy, dignity, and confidentiality of all students and employees at Founders. This policy covers employee/personnel records, student records, medical information, and other personally identifiable sources of information. It is the policy of the Founders that such personally identifiable information should only be viewed or received by someone with a legitimate educational interest in viewing or receiving the information, as well as those officials involved in a supervisory capacity over the school in which the students are enrolled. All Founders employees and Board of Trustees shall comply with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).
